TANZANIA



Tanzania has the largest game reserves of all Africa. They are dedicated to hunting safaris. Therefore they are not permitted to agricultural activities neither it is allowed to build any permanent construction. They are fully dedicated to wild animal life.

The three game reserves are: Selous, Burigi and Massai. The reserves will be reached using charter airplane from Dar Es Salaam or Arusha.

The Selous, 50.000.000 acres, has been classified National Game Reserve since the beginning of the 20th Century.

Tanzania is a unique destination for hunting very diversified African game (Elephant, Caffer Buffalo, Lion, Leopard, Kudu, Cap Eland....).

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Caffer Buffalo is a mythical game as being extremely dangerous. They leave in herd and very few old male alone. When stalking Buffalo you will come 100 yards from them.

Deciding to pull the trigger to shoot is a difficult decision. Any one having done it, knows that it may have been deciding to start war !

Those who had to track a wounded Buffalo, to finish what was poorly started have recollection for their entire life.

Shooting period starts in July at the end of the rainy season until November.



LODGING

As no permanent construction is allowed, camps are settle and dismantled every year. Each camp is equipped with a common dining room with a thatched roof over a timber framework where meals are served. Each hunter has a tent with its own

private toilet facilities. Camps have satellite telephone.



Days start at 6:00 in the morning and hunting is interrupted around noon (with the heat animals tend to lay down and wait for late afternoon). It is then time to go back to the camp for lunch and a rest before going back hunting later in the afternoon until 6:00 PM which is time of sunset.

Hunt is conducted on foot and 4 wheels car are used to reach the hunting zone.

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
